


In spite of their desire to create start-ups and integrate new ideas, most young people of the region struggle to acquire knowledge, develop new skills and find like-minded people, besides receiving community validation.

Such goals require constant access to new technologies and innovative working practices that are not always at hand for them.





Could we break down the barriers in entrepreneurship education and business related skills to support young people?



Firstly we selected 150 young people from Romania and Ukraine for participation in experience exchange activities, in face-to-face interactive discussion with companies representatives. They shared successful experiences, challenges and tips in business field and acting EU practices.





We organized 2 training sessions in Tulcea (Romania) for 50 young people from Romania and 25 students from Ukraine provided the opportunity for youth not just to learn, but to practice their skills. They developed real Business Plans under the assistance of specialists.

As a result, youngsters were made aware of modern leading EU business educational practices & tools for establishing new businesses.





Then we developed and launched the CREDA educational interactive tool that includes specialized content (online marketing, e-Banking, ERP, etc.) and constant free access to the platform for consultations and support.

- ✓ 1 vocational training program and authorization according to the legislation of adult training in Romania and Ukraine;
- ✓ 1 "Entrepreneurial Information Center" modernized;
- ✓ 75 business plans were developed and 10 business intentions were submitted on cross-border level.
- ✓ CREDA SYSTEMS 2 educational tools for development of business skills, specialized interactive entrepreneurial content and constant support were created and integrated in Romanian and Ukrainian educational institutions. Platform is available for the young people for access in browser or as an app in Google Play or AppStore.
